2. What common reasons have people given you for not going to church or not attending regularly?

Observation

3. The writer of Hebrews mentions that Jesus' sacrifice for our sin gives us confidence in our relationship with God (cf. 10:21-22). What impact should this have on how we approach church?
4. In what ways might attending church help us to draw near to God?

Meaning

5. How do different elements of our services help us to "hold fast to the confession of our hope?" (cf. 10:23)
6. How would you answer someone who said I don't need to go to Church to be a Christian?

Application

7. Read 1 Corinthians 14:26. Discuss ways we can make our church attendance more focused on building up other people.
8. Hebrews 10:24 says that one of the reasons we meet together is to encourage each other to love others and do good works. How can our church better demonstrate love towards other people in and outside the church?
